

## WEEKLY STREET MAINTENANCE UPDATE

This week contractors removed curbs and sidewalks on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Market Street from 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 10<sup>th</sup> Street, and Pine Street from 4<sup>th</sup> Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Street. For next week, curb forming and pouring will begin with North 10<sup>th</sup> Street and move on to Market and Pine. Proceed with caution as traffic controls and large cement trucks will be in the areas.



This Monday, brick repairs begin on the brick road sections of South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and South 5<sup>th</sup> Street. The City's contractor will be replacing damaged bricks and leveling the base underneath areas prone to puddling.



Public Works also reminds residents to join Public Works and Alderman Patrick Fagan to attend a public meeting on Saturday, July 8, at 10:00 A.M at City Hall, 200 South 4th Street in Council Chambers on the second floor. Various sections of curb and gutter are constructed of sandstone and will be difficult to replace. The City is considering several options and would like input from residents.
