DeKalb Police Make Arrest after Search Warrant

On July 14, 2022, the DeKalb Police Department, and the DeKalb County Special Operations Team (SOT) executed a search warrant at 823 Kimberly Drive (Apt. #4) DeKalb, Illinois. The search warrant was conducted without incident and led to one of the largest seizures in the DeKalb Police Department History.

The search warrant yielded the following seizures:

- Over 10 Pounds of Cannabis
- (84) Pills of Ecstasy
- Four (4) Illegal Firearms (One of which was stolen)
- Approximately \$130,000 United States Currency
- 2.5 Pints of Promethazine

The search warrant was successfully executed by the brave and professional Police Officers from the DeKalb Police Department and the DeKalb County Special Operations Team. We would like to extend praise to the DeKalb Police Department Detective Division, Patrol Division, and Communications Division for the exceptional teamwork displayed during this stressful and extremely dangerous situation.
