Shooting

On June 8, 2025, at approximately 1:34 a.m., the DeKalb Police Department received numerous 911 calls of shots fired, in the 2200 block of Eves Circle East DeKalb, Illinois. Upon arrival, DeKalb Police Department officers located a male subject who had suffered multiple gunshot wounds. DeKalb Police Department officers immediately rendered aid to the wounded subject until advanced medical aid could arrive. DeKalb Police Department officers also made contact with a second male subject who advised that he had initially called 911 and further explained that there was an altercation, and he had shot the wounded subject. The victim sustained life-threatening injuries and was transported to an area hospital in Rockford, Illinois for advanced medical care. DeKalb Police Department officers recovered and secured a firearm from the subject who shot the victim. The subject who shot the victim is a valid Firearms owner identification card holder and a valid concealed carry license holder. DeKalb Police Department officers transported the subject to the DeKalb Police Department for further questioning. The subject is actively cooperating with the DeKalb Police Department.

This investigation is in the preliminary stages, and no charges have been filed at this time.
