Shooting

On August 13, 2025, at approximately 11:47 a.m., DeKalb Police Department officers responded to the 100 block of North 10th Street, after receiving numerous 9-1-1 calls of a subject firing a gun at people. Officers arrived at the scene and all the subjects involved had fled the area; however, DeKalb Police Department officers did recover five (5) 9mm ammo casings from the roadway. After a preliminary investigation, officers determined that a person identified as John O. Contreras was observed at the scene of the shooting while riding a bicycle.

On August 14, 2025, members of the DeKalb Police Department and the DeKalb County Special Operations Team (SOT), executed a court authorized search warrant at 118 S. 7th Street (upper unit). John O. Contreras was located in the residence and arrested without incident. John O. Contreras is currently on Parole/Mandatory Supervised Release Custody, and he does not possess a valid Firearm's Owner's Identification Card, nor does he possess a valid Illinois Concealed Carry License.
