PRESS RELEASE

On May 3rd, 2017, at 12:41 pm, the DeKalb Police Department received a report of a domestic dispute in the 800 block the Kimberly Drive. The victim reported that the offender displayed a handgun during the argument.

DeKalb Police Officers arrived on scene and observed the offender as he fled from the building. Police identified themselves to the offender and ordered him to stop but he ran from police. Officers pursued the offender, on foot, and were able to apprehend him in the 900 block of Greenbrier Road. The offender, identified as Darrin Redmond, 22 years of age, of DeKalb, was found to be in possession of a loaded handgun. Further investigation determined that Redmond has a previous felony conviction.

Redmond was charged with Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by a Felon, a Class 3 felony; Unlawful Possession of a Firearm without a FOID Card; and Resisting a Peace Officer - both Class A Misdemeanors. Additional charges are expected to be filed against Redmond.

The Northern Illinois University Police Department assisted in the apprehension of Redmond.
