PRESS RELEASE - 6/1/20

On 5/31/2020, a group of citizens gathered at the DeKalb Police Department to demonstrate against police brutality. The demonstrators walked to Annie Glidden Rd and Hillcrest Dr and ended without issue. DeKalb Police Officers and Northern Illinois University Police Officers directed traffic and helped facilitate the walk.

As the walk ended, a crowd of people gathered in the same area. Multiple subjects began breaking into businesses and stealing items. This behavior continued until more police officers arrived and eventually gained control of the area. Additional burglaries were attempted throughout DeKalb and multiple arrests were made related to the crimes. Investigators are reviewing multiple sources of intelligence including surveillance video and have identified additional suspects. All of these crimes are still under investigation and additional arrests are expected. We recognize the professionalism and perseverance of the officers involved in these incidents.
