

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE DEKALB SYCAMORE AREA  
TRANSPORTATION STUDY'S (DSATS) FY11-15 TRANSPORTATION  
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENT #1**

The DeKalb-Sycamore Area Transportation Study (DSATS) is the metropolitan planning organization for all or portions of the City of DeKalb, the City of Sycamore, the Town of Cortland, and DeKalb County. The DSATS FY11-15 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #1 will be available for public review and comment from **Thursday, September 2, 2010 to Friday, September 10, 2010.**

The U.S. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has approved a Transportation, Community, and System Preservation (TCSP) grant for the construction of a bike path along Fairview Dr. in DeKalb between 1<sup>st</sup> St. and IL-23, which will cover 80% of the construction with City of DeKalb Motor Fuel Taxes covering the 20% local match. In order to receive these federal grant funds, this project must be added to the DSATS FY11-15 Highway TIP before September 15, 2010. Also, a project to install a roundabout at Glidden and Rich Roads has been cancelled and is being removed from the TIP. If you wish to comment or get more information on this project, please contact DSATS staff.

The public involvement procedures used in the development of the TIP satisfy the program-of-project requirements of Section 5307. The document is available at the following locations:
