

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE DEKALB SYCAMORE AREA
TRANSPORTATION STUDY'S (DSATS) FY11-15 TRANSPORTATION
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENT #2**

The DeKalb-Sycamore Area Transportation Study (DSATS) is the metropolitan planning organization for all or portions of the City of DeKalb, the City of Sycamore, the Town of Cortland, and DeKalb County. The DSATS FY11-15 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #2 will be available for public review and comment from **Monday, October 18, 2010 to Wednesday, November 17, 2010.**

The U.S. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has approved a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant for the upgrading of signs along Annie Glidden Road between IL-38 (Lincoln Hwy) and Dresser Rd. in DeKalb. The upgraded signs will have higher reflectivity to conform to the FHWA signage codes as published in the 2009 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The project will be funded with 80% Federal HSIP grant funds, with City of DeKalb Motor Fuel Taxes funding the 20% local match. In order to receive these federal grant funds, this project must be added to the DSATS FY11-15 Highway TIP after the completion of a 30-day Public Comment period.

The public involvement procedures used in the development of the TIP satisfy the program-of-project requirements of Section 5307. The document is available at the following locations:
