Subject: Approval of the DSATS FY09-13 TIP Amendment

Dear IDOT, FHWA, and FTA Officials:

This letter is being sent to inform you that the DeKalb Sycamore Area Transportation Study (DSATS) approved the Amendment to its FY09-13 TIP at its March 11, 2009 meeting.

The public comment period was published in the DeKalb Chronicle on Wednesday, February 25, 2009 with the public comment period running from February 25, 2009 to March 11, 2009 and a public hearing held before the DSATS meeting on March 11, 2009.

At the meeting, the Technical Advisory and Policy Committees voted to recommend that two roadways be reclassified to Federal Aid Urban (FAU) roadways.

1. Dresser Rd. – From Glidden Rd. to N. 1st St., reclassify as a Major Urban Collector
2. First St. – Add First Street (County Highway 35) as a Federal aid urban minor arterial from Gurler Rd. southwesterly 1.09 mile to Keslinger Rd.; all located within the De Kalb-Sycamore MPO urbanized area.
3. First St. – Add First Street (County Highway 35) as a Federal aid rural major collector from Keslinger Rd. south 3.31 miles to Perry Rd.; all located outside the De Kalb-Sycamore MPO urbanized area.
