YOUR WASTE OIL

DTMA operates a waste oil heater in the Airport Maintenance Hangar as a means of cutting costs on gas bills.

During snow removal operations, snow removal equipment is pulled out of the hangar to plow and is put away when the Airport is operational again. We have to open the large hangar door to get the equipment out which causes all the heat to escape.

As you can imagine, it takes a long time and is very expensive to regain the heat in the hangar. When we have completed plowing, and all equipment is the temperature of an ice cube, the hangar door is opened and the equipment is put away. Once again, it takes a very long time to recover the heat in the hangar. The waste oil heater eases the use of the natural gas infrared heaters when we have the hangar door open frequently.

If you have containers of waste oil in your hangar, Chuck Lanning, Airport Maintenance, will pick it up; or, you can drop it off at the Maintenance facility at 2200 Pleasant Street.

Please contact Chuck at 815-739-0728 if you have waste oil. He has spare containers for you to use and he can save your containers once he has emptied them.
