

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE DEKALB SYCAMORE AREA
TRANSPORTATION STUDY'S (DSATS) DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE
(DBE) PROGRAM PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The DeKalb Sycamore Area Transportation Study is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for all or portions of the City of DeKalb, the City of Sycamore, the Town of Cortland, and DeKalb County. The City of DeKalb Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program will be available for public review and comment from **Thursday, June 16, 2016 to Monday, August 1, 2016**.

The DBE program identifies how the City of DeKalb and the Voluntary Action Center shall ensure equal opportunity for female and minority owned businesses to compete in the DeKalb urbanized area transit procurement process.
