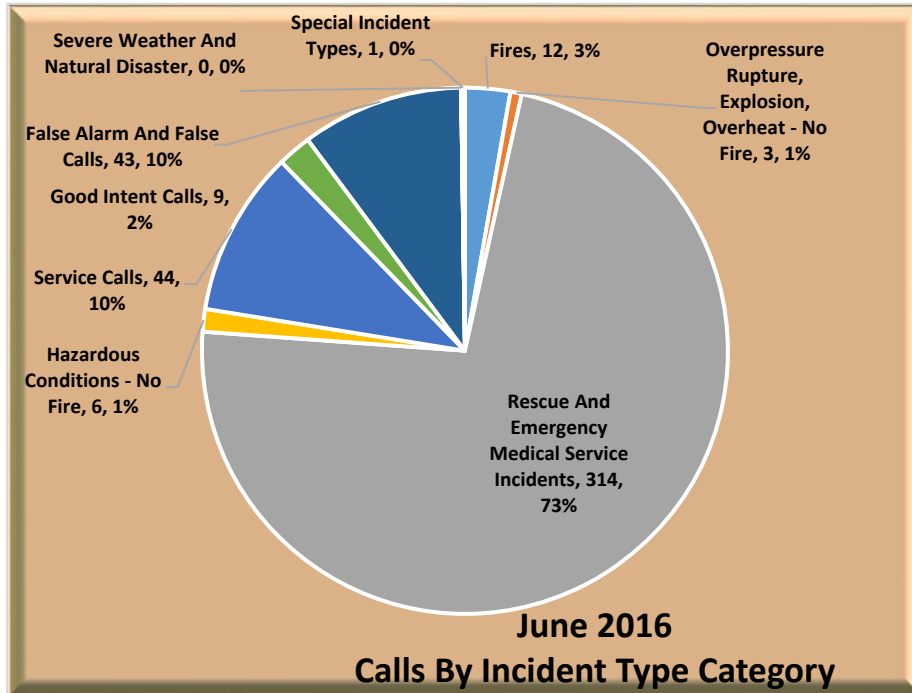

Operations

The DeKalb Fire Department responded to 432 incidents in June 2016. Emergency medical requests accounted for 314 (72.68%) of the monthly total. The remaining 118 (27.32%) of the incidents were fire/rescue related requests.

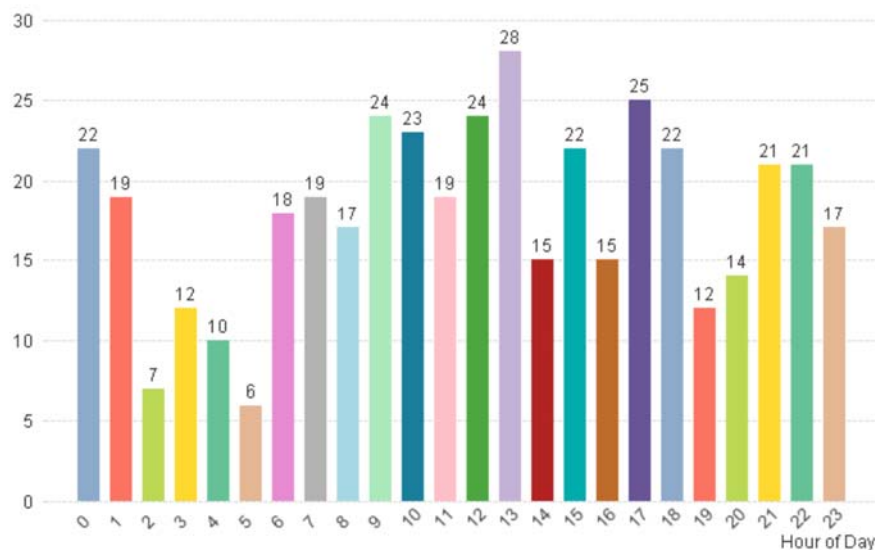
Mutual aid was provided to other communities on 4 incidents and was requested by DeKalb for 4 total incidents.



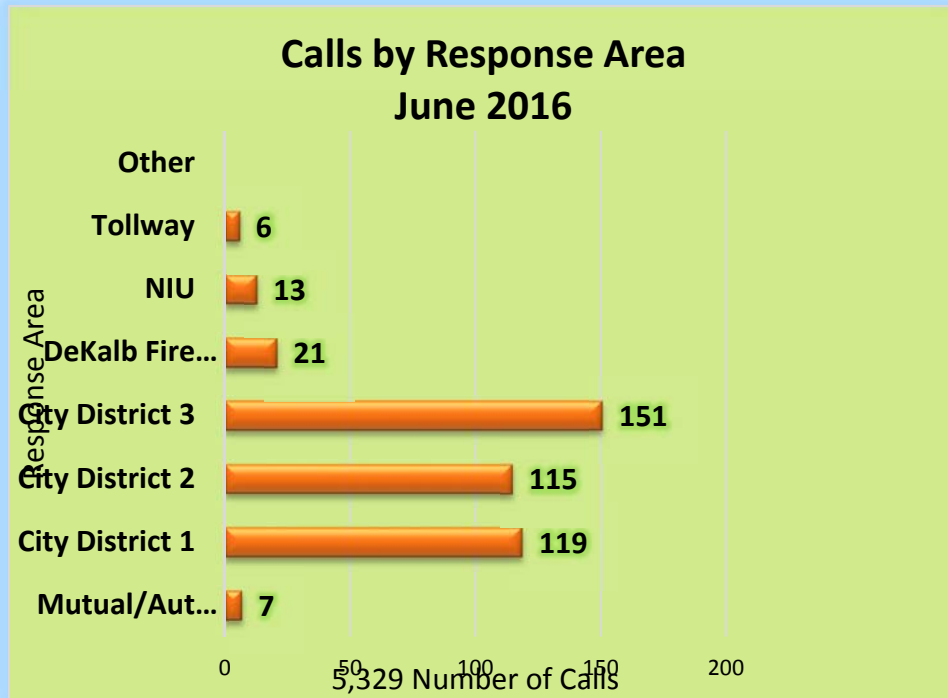
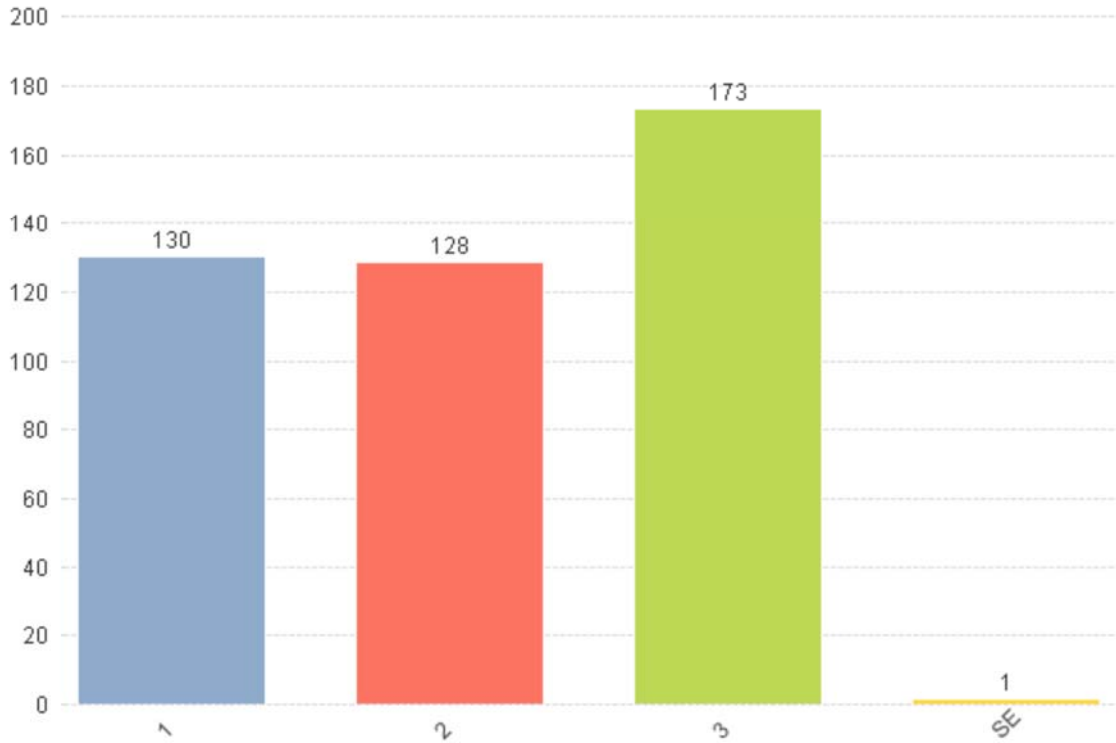
Calls by Hour of the Day

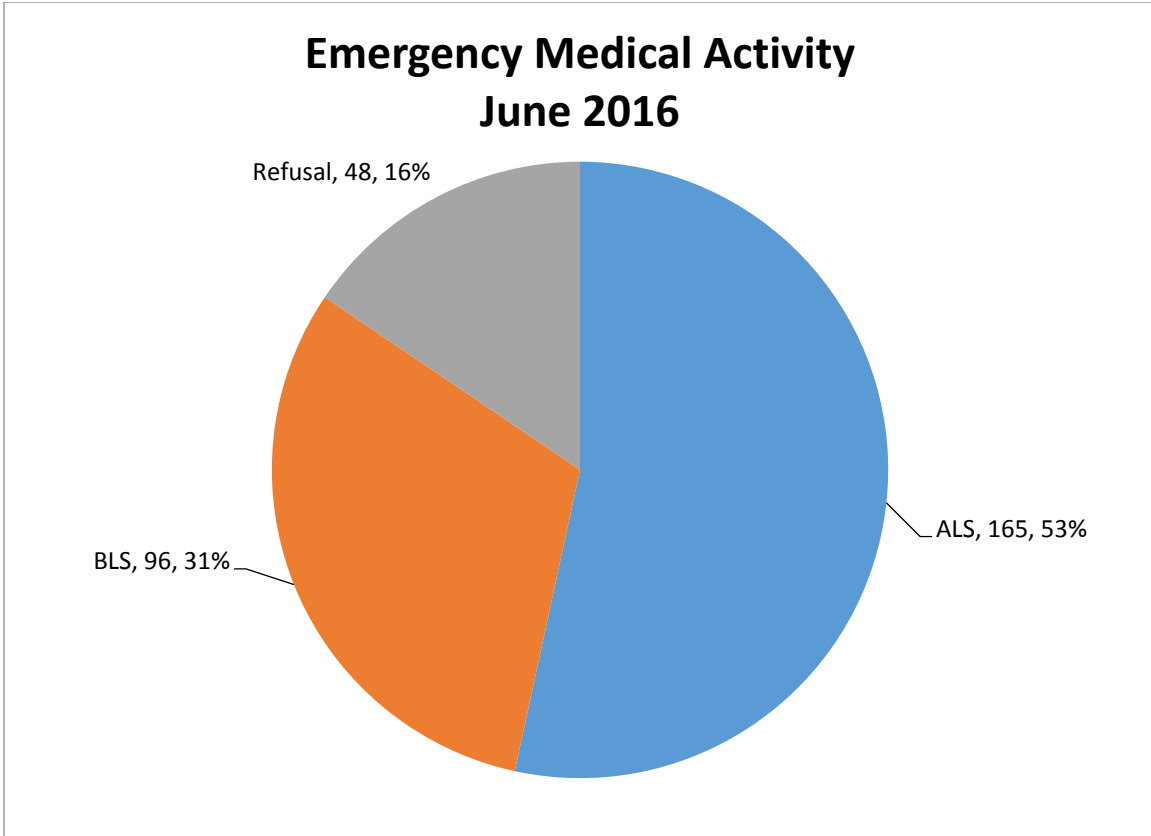
June 2016

432 Total Incidents

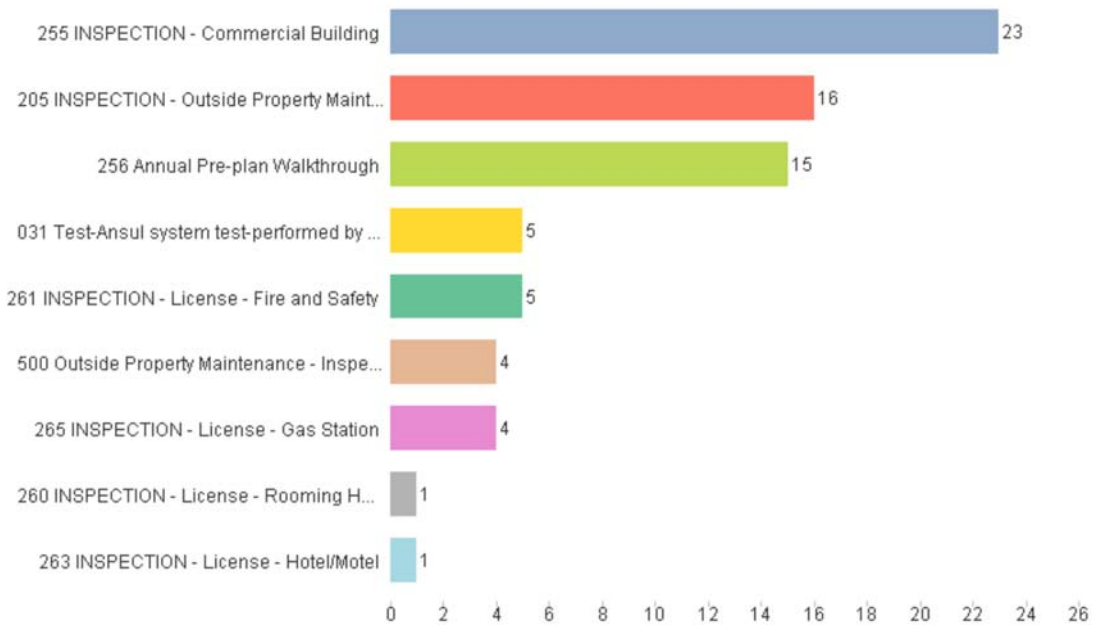


Calls By Station

Training

DeKalb firefighters spent 1,711 hours training during June 2016. Highlights of the June training schedule included:

- . Mobile training tower set-up and tear down.
- . Aerial ladder truck operation training.
- . Annual emergency medical skills testing to maintain EMS system certification.
- . MABAS Division 6 Hazmat Team conducted drills focusing on decontamination.
- . Haz Mat Coordinator/Technician Tom Conley deployed in Decon 6, along with one hazmat technician from Sycamore, to the Illinois National Guard Training Center in Marseilles, IL for a statewide hazmat training exercise.
- . Fire crews performed annual hose testing at Station 1.
- . All fire crews received large area search training within the DeKalb Park District building on Locust Street.
- . New heart monitors were received and programmed for all ambulances. The technology in these new monitors will incorporate the cardiac rhythm strip into the patient care report.

Administration

June administrative highlights include:

- . Fire Chief Eric Hicks attended the Kishwaukee Education Consortium Breakfast at Kishwaukee College.
- . DeKalb Fire Department personnel, along with family members, participated in the City of DeKalb's Memorial Day Parade.
- . DeKalb Fire Department held a ceremony to dedicate and reveal the new aerial ladder truck to the public, followed by the truck being placed in service.
- . Jonathon Ritter was sworn in and began his new position as a City of DeKalb Firefighter on June 6.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jim Zarek and an ambulance crew participated in the active shooter drill hosted by the Sycamore Fire Department.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster attended the DeKalb County Health Department's medication distribution full-scale exercise at the DeKalb County Outreach Building.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster attended an operations meeting with Deputy Police Chief John Petragallo to discuss interoperability matters.
- . Fire Chief Eric Hicks, Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster, and Battalion Chief Tony Cox participated in impending severe weather and tornado joint planning with Police Commander Tracy Smith and Communications Coordinator Latoya Marz.
- . Preparation was completed for the severe storms that were anticipated to hit DeKalb.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster attended the National Night Out meeting at the DeKalb Police Department to plan the upcoming event.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Eric Hicks, Commander Jason Leverton, and Administrative Analyst Traci Lemay worked on the Event Action Plan and emergency management planning of the 4th of July activities at Hopkins Park with the DeKalb Park District.
