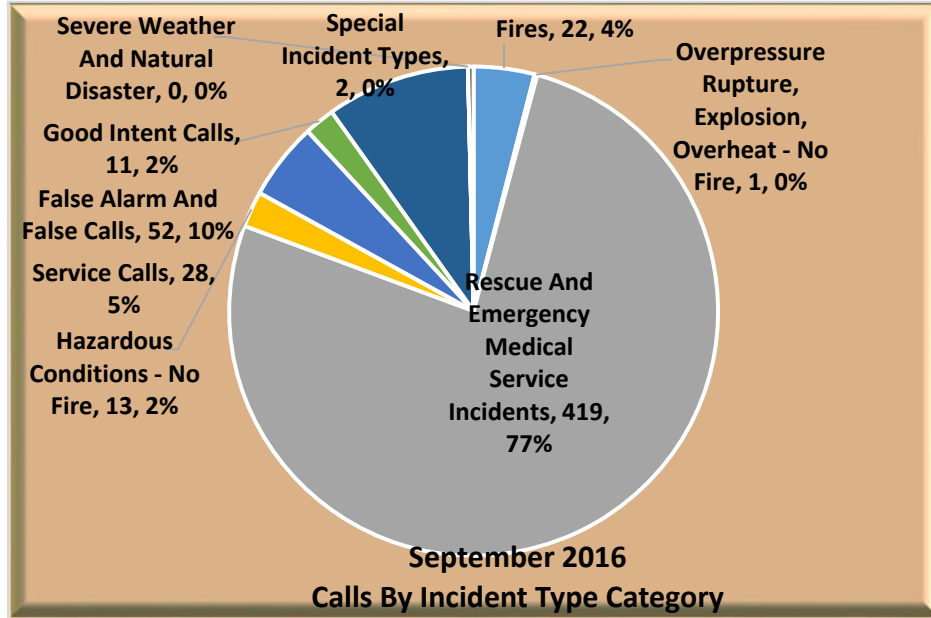

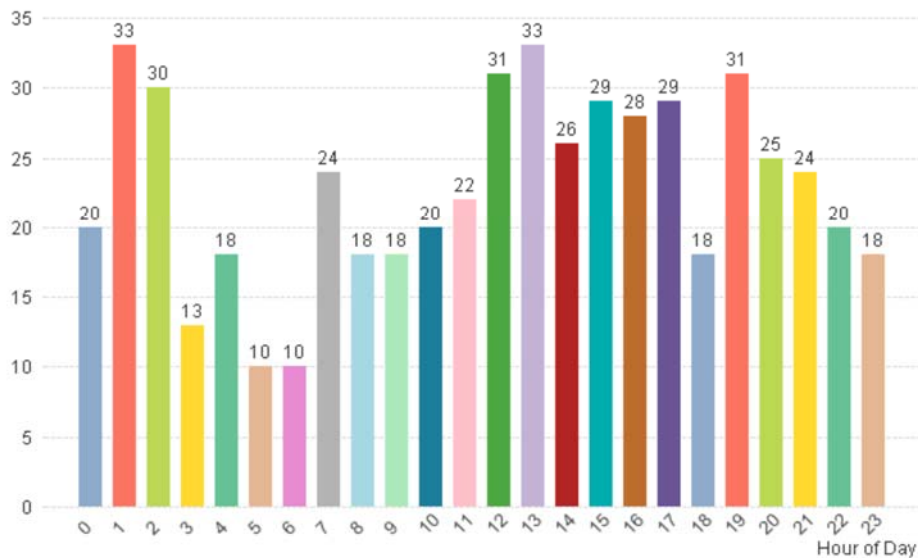
Operations

The DeKalb Fire Department responded to 548 incidents in September 2016. Emergency medical requests accounted for 418 (76.27%) of the monthly total. The remaining 130 (23.73%) of the incidents were fire/rescue related requests.

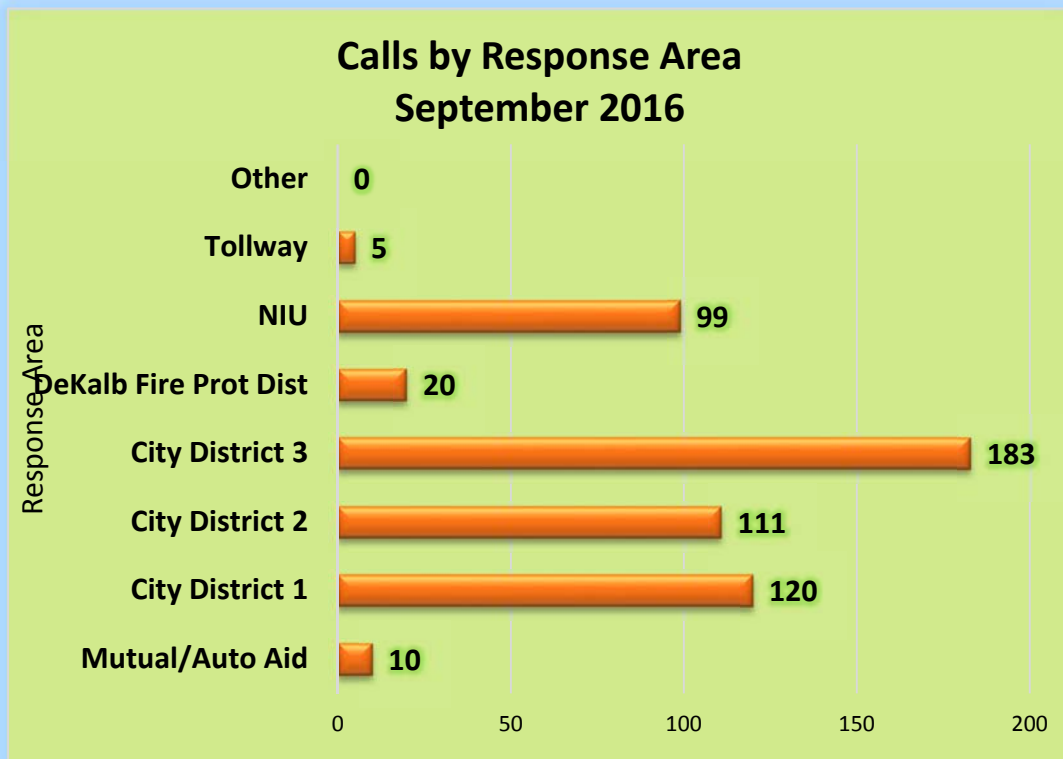
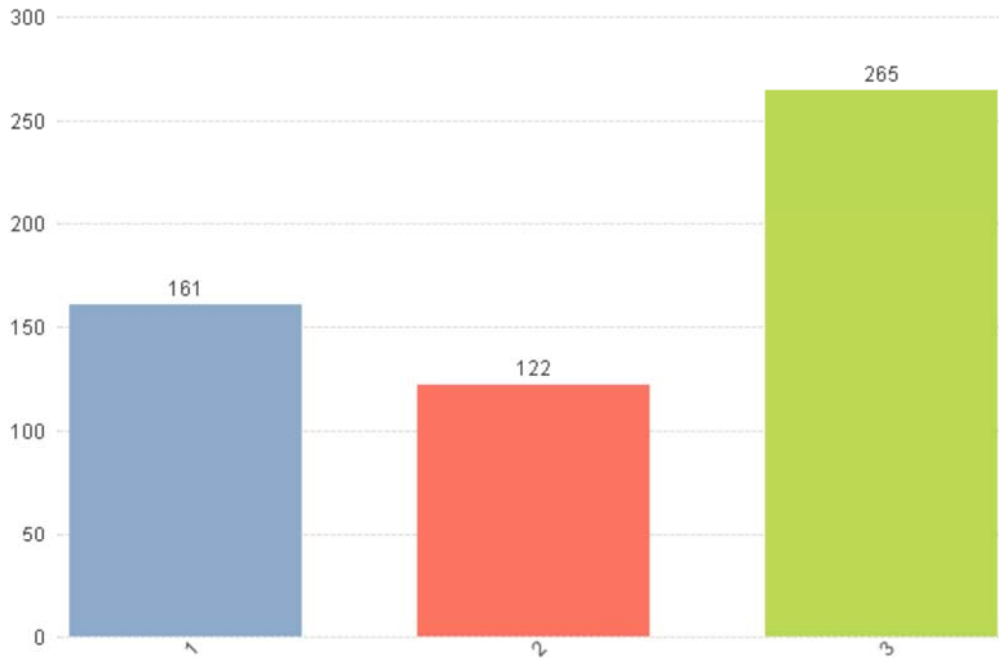
Mutual aid was provided to other communities on 14 incidents and was requested by DeKalb for 4 total incidents.

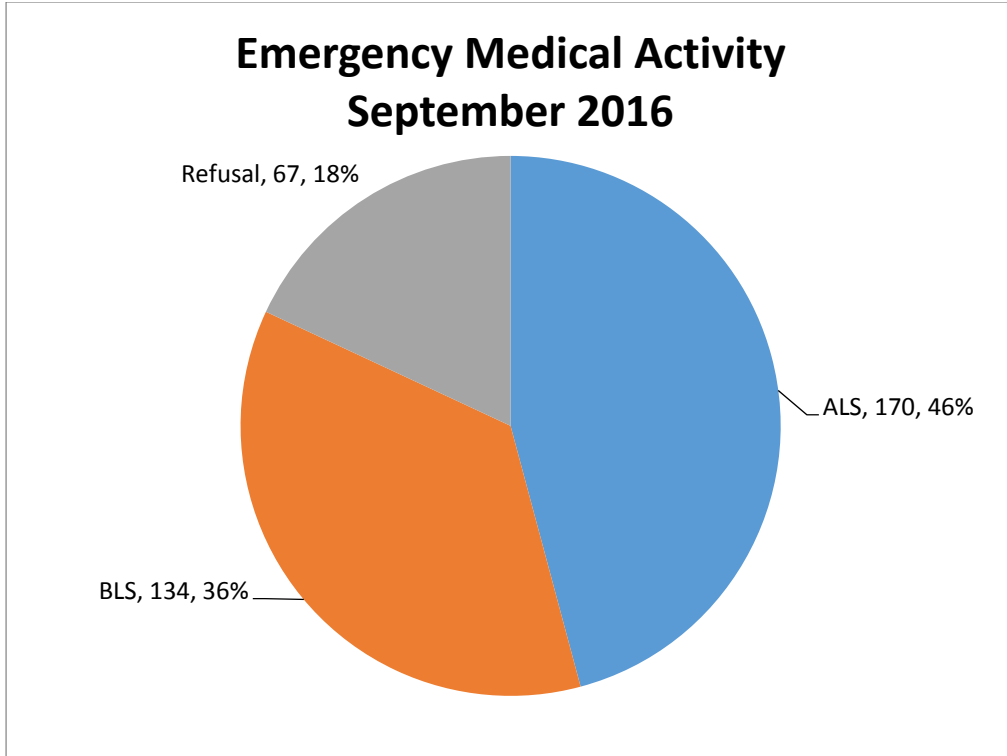


Calls by Hour of the Day

548 Total Incidents

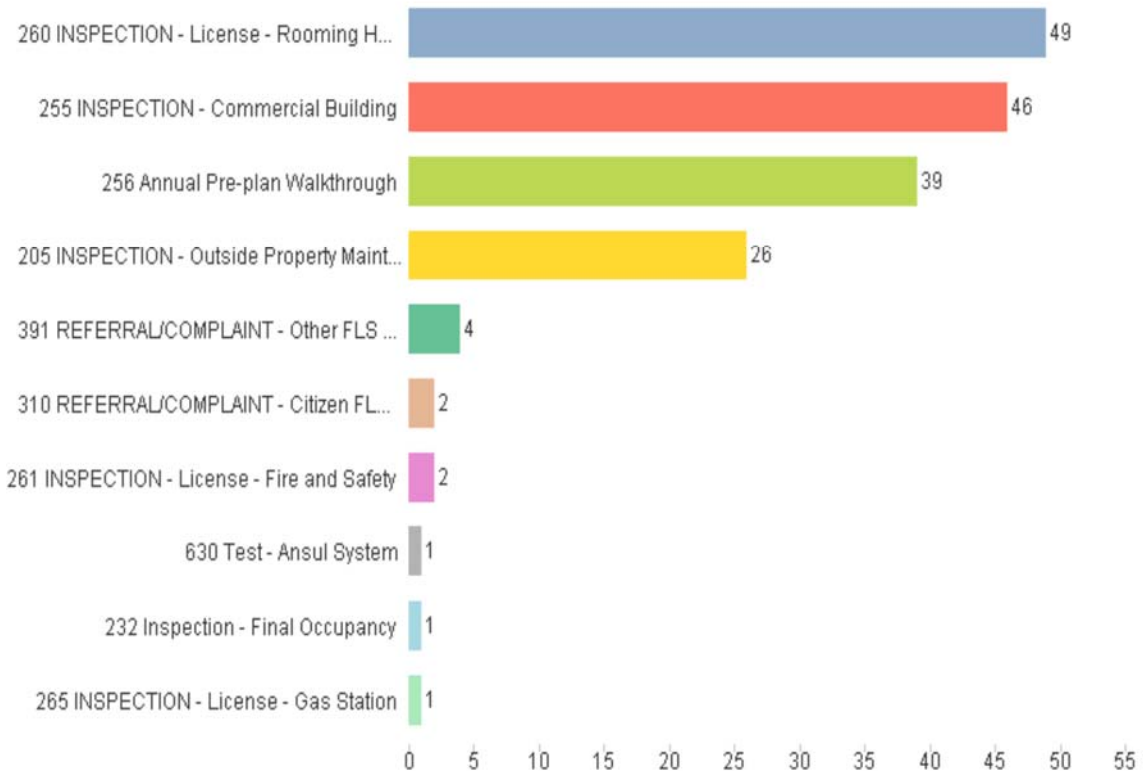


Calls By Station

Training

DeKalb firefighters spent 1,381 hours training during September 2016. Highlights of the September training schedule included:

- . Annual NIU Football game day procedure review and sports injury training,
- . Uses and applications of lock out tools,
- . Uses and application of the Hurst mini-lite system,
- . Peer fitness training,
- . Haz Mat team members attended HazMat IQ training, which taught members identification techniques for hazardous materials substance identification
- . Building tour and familiarization of Oak Crest, and
- . Chemical suicide.

Administration

September administrative highlights include:

- . Request for Proposals with bid specifications were prepared and released to purchase two new ambulances.
- . Fire Administration and on duty firefighters were honored at a RAMP Luncheon for their support of the RAMP program.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster participated in the Joint Operation Center training for ComEd emergencies.
- . Fire Chief Eric Hicks and Deputy Fire Chief James Zarek attended the 3M groundbreaking and reception. Clayco sent a thank you note to Fire Chief Eric Hicks expressing their gratefulness for Deputy Fire Chief Jim Zarek and Fire Prevention Lieutenant Tom Guthrie's "amazing professionalism" and service throughout the 3M building process.

Public Education/Community Event Participation

September highlights include:

- . DeKalb County Toy Run parade
- . Ambulance crews provided emergency medical standby at NIU football games, Phi Rho Eta Dance, and DeKalb High School vs Sycamore High School Football game.
- . Deputy Fire Chief Jeff McMaster participated in the "Who's Knocking At Your Door" program presented to senior citizens at St. Mary's Community Center to bring awareness of fire department services and potential scams.
- . The Fire Department held their annual Open House in conjunction with the DeKalb Firefighters' Historical Foundation's 5th annual pancake breakfast. Nicor, ComEd, and AllState provided static displays. Approximately 500 community members attended the event this year.
- . Fire Chief Eric Hicks and Firefighter/Paramedic Tom Conley participated in the Northern Illinois University (NIU) Safety Awareness presentation at the Duke Ellington Ballroom where they discussed cooking fires, alcohol/drug related emergencies, and general fire safety with NIU students.
- . Touch A Truck events were held at a block party on Garden Street, block party for Conexion Comindad, St. Mary School Family Fun Fest, DeKalb Public Library, block party at Liberty Park and Brooks Elementary school Fall Fest
- . Tours of Station 1 were provided to Clinton Rosette students, a local family
