

**TEMPORARILY WAIVING CHAPTER 3, "CITY ADMINISTRATION", SECTION 3.46, "RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS," FOR THE HIRE OF AN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DIRECTOR.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of DeKalb is a home rule municipality which has previously adopted Section 3.46 of the City Code, contemplating a residency requirement for the position of Information and Technology Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that such requirement is no longer advantageous or in the City's best interests relative to an immediate hire;

**THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of DeKalb, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** Subsection (c) of section 3.46 of the City Code which imposes a residency requirement for the Information Technology Director of the City of DeKalb shall be waived, relative to the hiring, retention and subsequent employment of an Information Technology Director to be hired by the City of DeKalb to fill an existing vacancy in this position. Said residency requirement shall be waived for the entirety of said Director's employment by the City.

**Section 2.** All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance, including the prior versions of the ordinances included above, are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and affect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and publication pursuant to law. Publication date: October 25, 2016. Effective date: November 3, 2016.
