

**ORDINANCE 13-61 Passed: October 14, 2013**

**AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DEKALB, ILLINOIS CHAPTER 51, "TRAFFIC," SECTION 51.13, "MUNICIPAL PARKING PROHIBITED," SCHEDULE C, "PARKING PROHIBITED" TO ADD JOHN STREET ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING AND SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL** of the City of DeKalb, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, Schedule C, "Parking Prohibited" be amended by deleting the following:

**~~John Street, East side.~~**

**Section 2.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51 "Traffic," Section 51.13, Schedule C "Parking Prohibited" be amended by adding the following in the appropriate place:

**John Street, both sides, from the south right of way line of College Avenue to a point 36 feet south**

**Section 2.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, Schedule C, "Parking Prohibited" be amended by adding the following in the appropriate place:

**"No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday."**

**John Street, East side, from 20 feet south of the south right of way line of Lincoln Way to a point 36 feet south of the south right of way line of College Avenue.**

**Section 3.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, Schedule C, "Parking Prohibited" be amended by adding the following in the appropriate place:

**"No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday."**

**John Street, West side, from 20 feet south of the south right of way line of Lincoln Way to a point 36 feet south of the south right of way line of College Avenue.**

**Section 4.** That the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois Chapter 51, "Traffic," Section 51.13, Schedule C, "Parking Prohibited" be amended by adding the following in appropriate place:

**John Street from Lincoln Way to College Avenue.**

**Section 5.** That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**Section 6.** That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all Sections of the Municipal Code of the City of DeKalb, Illinois shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 7.** Upon its passage and approval according to law, this Ordinance shall, by authority of the City Council be published in pamphlet form. On the tenth day after the date of publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. Publication date: October 15, 2013. Effective date: October 15, 2013.
