

Street Maintenance

The City’s street maintenance program began on July 5. The program consists of three types of maintenance.

- 1. Mill and Overlay is the first type of maintenance. This two-step process begins with the removal of damaged pavement via a milling machine. The machine grinds the surface to a fine matter and shoots it into a dump truck following closely behind. Once milled to specification, workers spray a liquid binder to assist the new asphalt overlay bind with the pavement. Streets scheduled for mill and overlay maintenance are listed below.

2. Replacing damaged bricks and leveling areas prone to puddling in the City’s historic district is the second type of maintenance scheduled. Years of moisture seeping into the base of the street has resulted in a weak base evident by the large pools of water after a rainfall. The contractor will remove the bricks manually, repair the base, and reinsert the bricks by hand to maintain the historical theme. Streets scheduled for brick maintenance are listed below.

3. Citywide Street patching is the final component to this year’s street maintenance program. Public Works and consultant Willett Hofmann inspected the following streets and identified large areas of salvageable pavement. The damages areas will be milled two inches and patched with asphalt.
